December-Christmas/Chanukah-reds, greens, snowmen, Santa, blues and silver

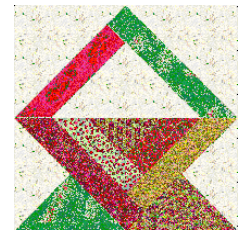
January – Plaids, stripes, dots, checks

Lemon Crisps

“Like eating sunshine in a crisp cookie”

1pkg Pillsbury® Moist Supreme Lemon Premium Cake Mix
(18.25oz)

1/3 cup Crisco oil

2 eggs

1/4 cup sugar

1 cup powdered sugar

2-3 tbs lemon juice

Yellow colored sugar



Heat oven to 375°. In a large bowl, combine cake mix, oil and eggs, stir with spoon until thoroughly moistened. Shape dough into 1-inch balls, place 2 inches apart on an ungreased cookie sheet. Place sugar in a shallow dish. Dip bottom of glass in sugar and flatten cookies to 1/4 inch thickness.

Bake at 375° for 5-7 minutes or until edges are light golden brown. Cool 1 minute and remove from cookie sheet.

In a small bowl, combine powdered sugar and lemon juice until smooth. Drizzle over cookies and sprinkle with colored sugar before icing sets. About 4 dozen cookies.
