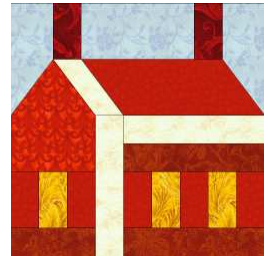

Both classes are full, with a waiting list.

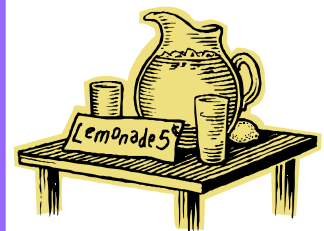
