We still have several openings for the August workshop with Mary Pavlovich. Please call Carol if you are interested in signing up. Come learn this technique and make a unique quilt.

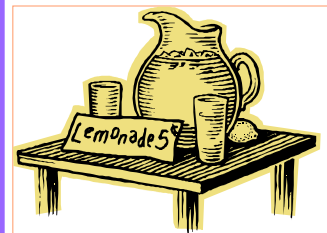

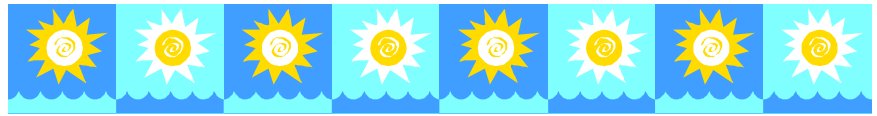

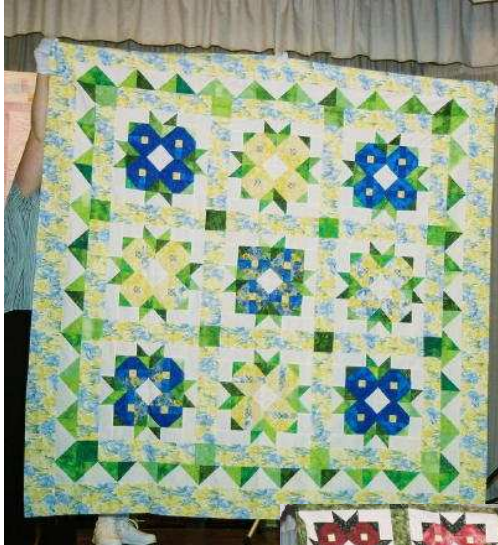
