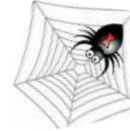

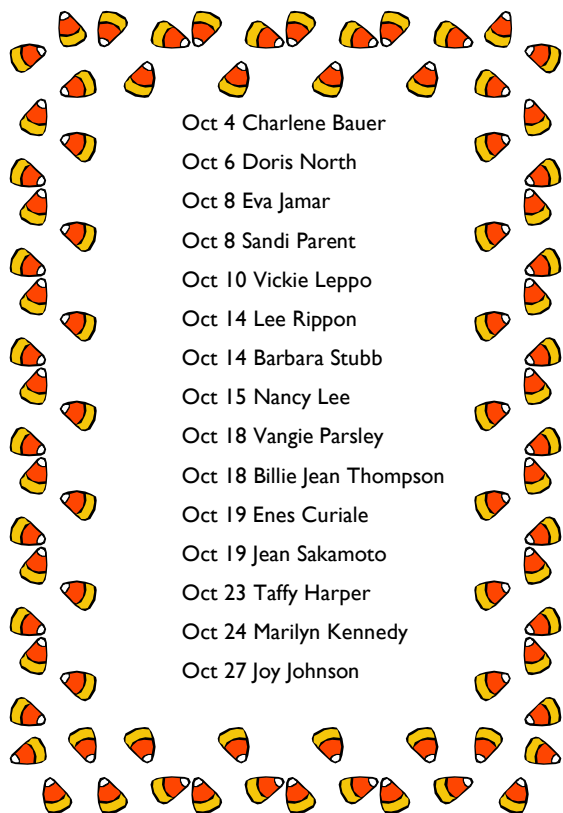

12" finished block

Orange Grove Quilters Guild 2008 Block of the Month - September

### IF USING YARDAGE

Color 1 (Dark) needs:  
1 strip 3 7/8" x 15 1/2"  
1 strip 3 7/8" x 7 3/4"

Color 2 (Medium) needs:  
2 squares 4 1/4"

Color 3 (Light) needs:  
1 strip 3 7/8" x 7 3/4"  
1 strip 3 1/2" x 14"  
2 squares 4 1/4"

### IF USING 5 INCH SQUARES

Color 1 (Dark) needs:  
4 squares 3 7/8"  
cut on diagonal  
2 squares 3 7/8" x 3 7/8"


Color 2 (Medium) needs:  
2 squares 4 1/4"

Color 3 (Light) needs:  
2 squares 3 7/8" x 3 7/8"  
4 squares 3 1/2"  
2 squares 4 1/4"

### CONSTRUCT THE BLOCK:

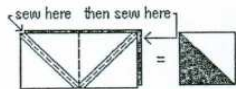
1. Mark the diagonals on the Color 3 (Light) 3 7/8" squares. Stack right sides together with the Color 1 (Dark) 3 7/8" squares. Sew a SCANT 1/4" above and below the marked diagonals. Cut apart on the marked diagonals between the rows of stitching. This will give you four half squares. Press seams to darker side and trim these to measure 3 1/2" if needed.
2. Starting at step 4 complete the block.

### CONSTRUCT THE BLOCK:

1. Start by marking and cutting the Color 1 (Dark) 3 7/8" x 15 1/2" strip into four 3 7/8" squares. Stack these and cut them once on the diagonal to make eight half square triangles. 

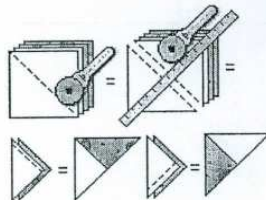
2. Mark and cut the Color 3 (Light) 3 1/2" x 14" strip into four 3 1/2" squares.

3. Now speed piece the center half squares, by stacking the Color 1 (Dark) and Color 3 (Light) 3 7/8" x 7 3/4" strips right sides together and all edges aligned. On the back of the top strip, mark the 3 7/8" square line. Mark the diagonals in the direction shown at left. Sew a SCANT 1/4" above and below the marked diagonals,



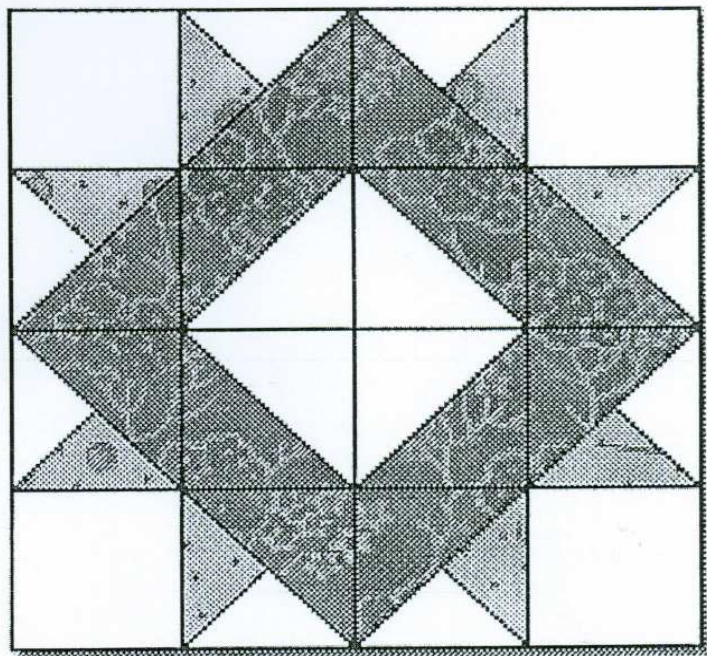
pivoting at the square line. Cut apart on the square line and on the marked diagonals between the rows of stitching. This will give you four half squares. Press seams to darker side and trim these to measure 3 1/2" if needed.

4. Next, stack the Color 2 (Medium) and Color 3 (Light) 4-1/4" squares and cut in half on the first diagonal. Leave them stacked and use a ruler to cut on the opposite diagonal. This will give you eight quarter square triangles of each color. **Sew pairs of these right sides together, half with the colors reversed.**



5. Then sew a Color 1 (Dark) half square triangle to each pair of quarter square triangles, pressing seams towards the half square triangles. Trim to measure 3-1/2" if needed.
6. Piece the block by first laying out the pieces to make sure they match the block drawing (see highlighted text in #4). When sewing the rows together be sure to alternate pressing directions.

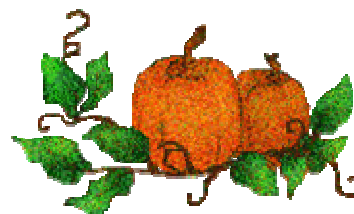
